

This was a couple of FAQ's I included in our camp email:

- This email contains the entire camp itinerary. Please note our groupings are by Grad Year. You only have to be at the facility during that time.
- The Group numbers are NOT the numbers you were assigned on your invite, they are by Grad Year.
- We will have an optional check in on Friday night if you are in town from 4:30pm - 8pm. This is a nice option if you are around to get checked in, get your t-shirt, get your picture done, and check out the facility. If you are not in town, no worries, you can still check in the time listed prior to your group start time. If you check in Friday night, you do not need to check in on Saturday morning.
- Our Kohl's Kicking Apparel store will be open Friday night and throughout the weekend in the Rock.
- Alex's Lemonade will be back again this year, stop by and see how you can be a Kohl's Champion.
- KS1 will also be available to check out footballs
- You are free to leave in between your sessions if you would like to get off your feet and out of the heat. The Mountains are beautiful, but this area is busy during this time of year so just a heads up that Rocky Top does have food available onsite in The Rock called Champs Grill. If you want to grab something to eat it may be a lot less hassle to eat at the facility before you head out or arrive early.
- **PROFILE VIDEOS:** If you have purchased a profile, an additional video, or have a premium profile we will be filming one charting session of each discipline. There is nothing else that you need to do.
- This is VERY important...Each session that you come in, you will chart for all you are signed up for. For example, if you are a Kicker you will need to make sure to do Field Goals and Kickoffs for EACH of the 3 sessions. If you are a Kicker and Punter, you will need to go to the Kickoff, Field Goal, and Punt field EACH of the 3 sessions to complete. You will be assigned a starting field, and you will receive that info when you check in. Coach Kohl will address this in the intro, we will also have QR Codes around the facility with info available.
- We will have an optional FCA (Fellowship of Christian Athletes) service in The Rock on Sunday at 7:00am - 7:30am. Completely optional but we invite any family that would like to attend.
- We will have water on the field for athletes, but I would recommend bringing plenty of water.
- Sunscreen and Bug Spray can also help during your time on the field.
- We are rain or shine, we will NOT reschedule. For any weather-related schedule changes, please check Twitter and we will plan to update info you can access via the QR code. Weather forecasts in the mountains change almost hourly. If storms pop up, generally they pass quickly and we are back on the field.
